# **Evidence-Based Home Visiting**

The Department of Health proposes to expand the evidence-based home visiting program across the state. This program helps parents provide a safe environment for their children by linking families to needed resources, developing parenting skills, and avoiding adverse childhood experiences. This increase will fund four public health program director positions and one epidemiologist to manage and oversee the grants.
