

## Financial Supports and Systems for Early Educator Career Pathways

High School Career and Technical Education	State of Tennessee/Local County	Provides high school students with no-cost coursework (including for college credit) and, in partnership with TECTA, the opportunity to gain an industry credential (Child Development Associate) before graduating.
TN Promise	State of Tennessee	Opportunity for high school graduates to attend community or technical college free of tuition and mandatory fees
<u>TN Reconnect</u>	State of Tennessee	Opportunity for adults to return to higher education and pursue an associate degree or technical degree free of tuition and mandatory fees
<u>Tennessee Grow Your</u> <u>Own</u>	State of Tennessee	Supports Teacher Occupation Apprenticeship programs between school districts and Educator Preparation Providers (EPPs)
<u>TN Future Teacher</u> Scholarship	State of Tennessee	Provides college students enrolled in an Educator Prep Program with scholarship in exchange for 4 years of service as a public school teacher in Tennessee
Minority Teaching Fellows Program	State of Tennessee	Provides a scholarship for minority college students who pursue a teacher certification and commit to teach in a Tennessee public school teacher for at least a year
Tennessee Student Assistance Award	State of Tennessee	Provides financial assistance to economically disadvantaged undergraduate Tennessee students
<u>Tennessee Hope</u> <u>Scholarship</u>	State of Tennessee	Provides scholarships to eligible high school graduates for tuition at four-year and two-year colleges and universities
<u>TN Early Childhood</u> <u>Training Alliance</u> ( <u>TECTA)</u>	ΤΕСΤΑ	Opportunity to receive financial assistance for CDA credential and/or degree in early childhood education or child development
WAGE\$ Program	TN Dept. of Human Services (Child Care WAGE\$ TN)	Provides education-based salary supplements to teachers and family childcare educators working with children 0-5
<u>Consolidated</u> <u>Business Grants</u> (CBG) Program	TN Dept. of Labor and Workforce Development	Uses federal WIOA funds to assist businesses to build the skills of their employees. Includes a grant type which provides up to 50% of a trainee's wages during a specified period of training by the employer, as well as grants to pay for apprenticeships.

<u>Workforce</u> <u>Innovation and</u> <u>Opportunity Act</u> (WIOA) Individual <u>Training Account</u> <u>funds</u>	TN Dept. of Labor and Workforce Development	Uses federal WIOA funds to pay for training to support an individual needing training to obtain or retain employment that leads to economic self-sufficiency or wage increases
Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF)	US Dept. of Education	Provides loan forgiveness to eligible borrowers who have worked in public service for at least 10-years
<u>Teacher Loan</u> Forgiveness Program	US Dept. of Education	Provides loan forgiveness to those employed as full-time highly qualified teachers for five complete and consecutive years at an elementary school or secondary school that serves low-income students
<u>Federal Perkins Loan</u> <u>Cancellation</u>	US Dept. of Education	Provides loan forgiveness to those employed as full-time highly qualified teachers for five complete and consecutive years at an elementary school or secondary school that serves low-income students
